

MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Senator Allen moved to approve the minutes of the January 25, 1984 meeting. Senator Parrish seconded the motion and it carried.

Senator Montgomery opened the hearing on S.B. 565, which would permit improvement districts in unincorporated areas to purchase or acquire emergency warning siren systems. Mrs. Gerry Ray spoke in support of the bill.

Senator Bogina explained the purpose of S.B. 566, which would correct inconsistencies in the statutes and remove the designated fee county clerks may charge for recording or copying reports other than those required by law or the county. Mrs. Gerry Ray also spoke in support of the bill.

Following discussion, Senator Bogina moved to report S.B. 565 favorably for passage. Senator Allen seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Gaar requested Senator Allen carry the bill. Senator Bogina then moved that S.B. 566 be reported favorably for passage. Senator Daniels seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously. Senator Bogina was asked to carry the bill.

Senator Gaar adjourned the meeting to February 1, 1984.
