

MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Senator Gaar opened the hearing on S.B. 584, establishing a minimum uniform expense allowance for sheriffs and deputies of certain counties. Mr. Fred Allen appeared before the committee to oppose the bill on behalf of the Association of Counties. Senator Gaar announced that the hearing would be rescheduled at a time when the sponsor of the bill could appear.

Mr. Ernie Mosher, on behalf of the League of Municipalities, appeared to explain and support S.B. 608, S.B. 609 and S.B. 610, all relating to funding of infrastructure improvements by municipalities.

Mr. Chris McKenzie appeared in support of S.B. 607, pertaining to the statute of limitations for filing civil rights actions to challenge special assessments.

Ms. Janet Stubbs expressed concern, on behalf of the Home Builders Association, as to the effect S.B. 606, previously heard by the committee, would have on the use of money builders pay into a pool for hook ups, which money must be used for expansion rather than maintenance.

Senator Mulich made the motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held February 1, 1984. Senator Allen seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote.

The meeting was adjourned to February 7, 1984.
