

MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

The meeting was called to order by Senator Gaar at

Senator Rehorn explained the purpose of S.B. 584, which would raise the expense allowance for maintenance of sheriffs' uniforms, and introduced Mr. Clester, who appeared in support of the bill. Mr. Tim Johnson also appeared as a proponent of the bill.

Senator Gaar noted that the proposed amendments to S.B. 619, relating to financing of sewer improvements in Butler County, are in the nature of clean-up, since existing law allows the policy. Senator Gaines moved to adopt the proposed clean-up amendments. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried. Senator Gaines moved the bill be passed as amended. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Gaines was asked to carry the bill.

Senator Bogina moved to report S.B. 620 adversely. Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Senator Gaar asked for discussion on S.B. 584. Senator Mulich suggested localizing the bill to Wyandotte County. Senator Allen suggested that more information is need prior to any action.

Senator Allen moved to approve the minutes of the February 7, 1984 meeting. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried.
