

MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Senator Gaar called the committee's attention to S.B. 631, concerning tax increment financing, and asked Mr. Chris McKenzie to lead a discussion of the proposed amendments. Mr. McKenzie distributed a balloon of the bill incorporating the amendments conceptually adopted by the committee at its February 15, 1984 meeting. At the suggestion of Senator Parrish, it was the consensus of the committee to include an amendment to require that an intent to pledge the issuer's full faith and credit be stated in the resolution setting the public hearing and to amend new section 7 of the bill, the authorization to issue the full faith and credit tax increment bonds, into the existing law, K.S.A. 12-1772.

Senator Allen moved to report the bill as amended favorably. Senator Bogina seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Senator Gaar asked Senator Parrish to carry the bill.

Senator Gaar called the committee's attention to S.B. 710, concerning awarding of bids for expenditures in excess for \$20,000 for construction of certain county improvements. Senator Montgomery asked if the bill was applicable to reconstruction, and Senator Mulich stated that the Attorney General had confirmed that it was. Senator Montgomery moved to amend the bill by substituting "and" for "or" where it appears as the third from the last word in line 0023. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried. Senator Mulich moved to report the bill as amended favorably. Senator Ehrlich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Mulich was appointed to carry the bill.

Senator Montgomery moved to approve the minutes of the February 15, 1984 meeting. Senator Bogina seconded the motion and it carried.

The meeting was adjourned to February 24, 1984.
