Mr. John McGuire appeared on behalf of Representative Fox to explain and support H.B. 2699, which provides that Johnson County Water District No. 1 meetings and records will be open to the public in accordance with the Open Records Act, and H.B. 2701, which would raise the dollar amount of contracts that must be let for public bid and permit audits by certified public accountants. Mr. McGuire introduced Mr. Anderson, who spoke in support of both bills on behalf of Water District No. 1.

Senator Allen moved to place both bills on the consent calendar. Senator Daniels seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.
