

MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Senator Montgomery opened the hearing on S.B. 836. Commissioner Leick explained that the bill would bring the Library Board under the administration of the Board of County Commissioners for certain purposes, i.e., personnel, payroll, purchasing, budgeting, insurance, etc., while preserving the corporate and politic status of the Library Board. Mr. Robinson and Mr. Fox appeared in support of the bill and answered questions of the committee members. Ms. Kiernan advised that certain technical amendments to the bill are necessary. Senator Gaines moved to amend the bill in accordance with Ms. Kiernan's recommendation. Senator Daniels seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Allen moved to report the bill as amended favorably for passage. Senator Daniels seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mr. Johnson appeared in support of S.B. 848, which would authorize a library board to hold or invest a gift or donation when no provisions for such gift or donation are specified. Following discussion, Senator Daniels moved to report the bill favorably for passage. Senator Gaines seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.

Senator Daniels moved and Senator Roitz seconded approval of the minutes of the meeting held March 21, 1984. The motion carried.
