The committee met for the purpose of hearing and considering S.B. 865, which would raise the outstanding bonded indebtedness limit in Wyandotte County to 6 percent of the assessed value of all tangible property, as certified by the county clerk on the preceding August 25. Mr. Cooper appeared in support of the bill on behalf of the Wyandotte County Commission. He also told the committee of the support of the League of Municipalities. Following discussion, Senator Mulich moved to report the bill favorably for passage. Senator Ehrlich seconded the motion and it carried by a vote of 5 for and 1 against. Senator Mulich was asked to carry the bill.

Upon motion made and seconded, the minutes of the March 27, 1984, meeting were approved.
