SYSTEMWIDE ISSUES - BOARD OF REGENTS

Mr. Monical continued his review of Legislative Research Department Budget Memo 84-2 (Attachment A, February 23, 1984). During his presentation there were questions from committee members concerning various subjects.

In connection with the Missing Data for Pittsburg State University on page 2-18 of the Budget Memo, Mr. Monical explained that contracts for the current fiscal year have not been signed, and the faculty is being paid as in the previous fiscal year. He further explained that members of the bargaining unit are basically faculty without administrative appointments. Some members pay dues to belong to the unit, but everyone below the Chair level is technically a member of the bargaining unit. There was a brief discussion concerning the Supreme Court case in this matter.

Other items questioned by members of the committee were student salaries, other operating expenditures, and utilities.

Mr. Monical concluded by calling the committee's attention to base budget reductions on page 2-43. There were questions about this part of the Budget Memo.

The meeting was adjourned by the Chairman.
