HB 3064 - Certificates of insurance issued, renewed or delivered within or outside state

Mr. Parks explained that HB 3064 would provide that no matter where an insurance policy is sold it would have to comply with minimum statutes of Kansas. He said it is supported by the Insurance Department. He stated the bill was requested by a coalition of chiropractors, psychologists, dentists, etc. There was a brief discussion following his explanation.

Motion was made by Senator Steineger and seconded by Senator Gaines to report HB 3064 favorably for passage. The motion carried by roll call vote.
