Hearing on S.B. 287 - Soil amendments, proof of efficacy when no active ingredients or claims made.

Larry Woodson explained the soil amendment act was originally passed in 1975, and was amended in 1982 to include a proof of efficacy requirement. S.B. 287 would amend the act to add definitions to help measure the value and usefulness of the product and to include a statement covering products for which no claim is made.

Representative Apt moved to pass out favorably S.B. 287.
Representative Buehler seconded the motion. The motion passed.
