The Chairman called the meeting to order by turning the Committee's attention to SCR 1628, commending postsecondary education institutions for efforts at cooperation and suggesting consideration of administration mergers.

Representative Apt explained the Resolution, drawing the attention of the Committee to the last paragraph of the Resolution. This bill would apply only to postsecondary institutes and would work on consolidating those institutes in close proximity, becoming a cost saving factor. She cited the situation of Coffeyville Community College and Liberty Community College as reasons for the short time factor of consideration on this bill.

Representative Miller made a motion to recommend SCR 1628 favorable for adoption. Representative Mayfield seconded the motion. The motion prevailed.
