

MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RESOURCES

Chairman Fox asked Representative Heinemann to give a summary of the Natural Resources Subcommittee meeting of February 6. Representative Heinemann reported that the subcommittee recommended that both House Bill 2094 and House Bill 2095 be passed by this committee, with a technical amendment on House Bill 2094 relating to the additional vendors that Fish and Game would provide to sell the permits.

An amendment that should have been in the original draft of House Bill 2095 indicates that the court shall suspend or revoke the convicted person's hunting or fishing license for a period of two years.

Representative Fry made a motion to amend House Bill 2095. Representative Heinemann seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative Heinemann moved that House Bill 2095 be recommended as amended favorably for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Webb. Motion carried.

Regarding House Bill 2094, Representative Heinemann moved to adopt the technical amendment which would strike the word "from" and insert "in an amount fixed by" on line 41. The motion was seconded by Representative Grotewiel. Motion carried.

Representative Heinemann made a motion that House Bill 2094 as amended be recommended favorably for passage. Representative Webb seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Chairman Fox announced that on Wednesday, February 13, the Energy Subcommittee would finish hearings on House Bill 2037 and House Bill 2041, as well as House Bill 2100. He asked that committee members advise him of any preferences they had regarding hearings on other bills now in committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:45 p.m.
