The meeting was called to order by Chairman Miller for the purpose of discussion of SB187 which deals with licensure of certain persons and private clubs.

Representative Vancrum made a conceptual motion, seconded by Representative Roe to amend SB187 as per attached. See attachment A. The motion carried.

Representative Vancrum made a motion, seconded by Representative Brady, to report SB187 favorable for passage as amended. The motion carried.

Representatives Sallee, Goosen, Walker, & Sprague were recorded as voting "no".

Representative Brady asked that an explanation of his second to the motion to report SB187 favorable as amended be entered into the minutes. "I made the second to pass this bill out of committee out of respect to the House Conference Committee on the liquor package agreement to give this bill a fair hearing on the floor of the House. It in no way reflects my support or lack of it for Sunday sales."

The meeting was adjourned.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SB 187

- (1) Permit cereal malt beverage wholesalers to distribute wine.
- (2) Allow Sunday sales of cereal malt beverages by licensees licensed for off-premise consumption only.
- (3) Allow wholesalers to deliver alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverage on election day.
- (4) Allow private clubs on trains.
- (5) Allow hotel guests temporary membership in a nonhotel club if the hotel has no club.
- (6) Allow clubs to sell liquor by the drink off the club premises at a bona fide private party.
- (7) Allow the Board of Regents to designate one nonclassroom building on each campus where alcohol could be consumed.
- (8) Permit sale of cereal malt beverage on Sundays at conventions and concerts.
- (9) Delete section 1.
