HOUSE BILL 2245 - HEARING

Judy Brown, representing Kansas National Education Association,
indicated support of House Bill 2245 on behalf of the association
and Craig Grant.

Marshall Crowther suggested the word "funeral" in Line 19 in
the bill title be changed to "death" as it is in the statute.

Representative Dyck moved to amend House Bill 2245 to change
"funeral" in Line 19 to "death;" seconded by Representative Williams.
The motion carried.

Mr. Crowther also mentioned that retired groups had requested
from him discussion of improvements of death benefits for retirants.

Representative Williams moved to amend House Bill 2245 by
changing the death benefit from \$2,500 to \$1,500 in Line 26; seconded by
Representative Wisdom. The motion carried.

The committee asked Mr. Crowther to submit figures in writing
for cost of death benefits.

The meeting adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
