SENATE BILL 159 - ACTION

The Chairman indicated SB 159 provides continuation of state contributions to TIAA paid by the Board of Regents which was heard in committee March 21.

Representative Wisdom moved that SB 159 be reported favorable for passage; seconded by Representative Francisco. The motion carried.

SENATE BILL 160 - ACTION

The committee discussed SB 160 which provides full death and disability for part-time Regent's faculty over age 60.

Representative Francisco requested an amendment to disallow full benefits if a faculty member obtains other employment. Attachment 1. After committee discussion, no vote was taken.

Representative Wisdom moved that SB 160 be reported adversely; seconded by Representative Laird. The motion carried.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO S.B. NO. 160

If the faculty member who has entered into a reduced-service agreement obtains other employment, in addition to employment under the reduced-service agreement, the educational institution shall not pay on behalf of such faculty member the amounts specified in this section but rather shall pay on a basis equal to the amount of time the faculty member is working under the reduced-service agreement.
