House Resolution 6007 - A resolution adopting permanent rules of the
House of Representatives for the 1985-1986 biennium.

Representative R.H. Miller moved and Representative Donna Whiteman seconded that the following changes be made to House Resolution 6007: The word "livestock" be changed to "small business" and, on line 244, change "seventeen" to "nineteen". The motion passed.

Chairman Keith Roe brought up Representative Dave Miller's objection to the sentence in Rule 1501 which reads "Appropriation bills reported by the Committee on Ways and Means shall have precedence over all others." Representative Dave Heinemann moved and Representative Miller seconded to strike the sentence from the Rules. The motion passed.

Representative Miller moved and Representative Heinemann seconded that the sentence "At the conclusion of debate the presiding officer shall inquire shall the chairperson's ruling be sustained," be added to Rule 1910 and to change the word "chairperson" in line 594 to "presiding officer." The motion passed.

Representative Heinemann moved and Representative Miller seconded that, in Rule 1030, a., the word "the" be inserted before the word "vacancy". The motion passed.

Representative Heinemann moved and Representative Miller seconded that House Resolution 6007 be reported favorably as amended. The motion passed.

Representative Miller moved and Representative Heinemann seconded that the minutes of January 17 be approved. The motion passed.
