Chairman Bunten called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m.

SB 338 -- an act concerning the state board of regents; relating to payment of tuition grants and state scholarships for students engaged in post-secondary education; amending K.S.A. 72-6108, 72-6109, 72-6110, 72-6811, 72-6812 and 72-6813 and repealing the existing sections.

Clantha McCurdy, representing state board of regents, addressed the committee and explained the bill. Passage of the bill would make it a requirement for tuition payments to be made directly to the institution in which the student is enrolled. Only one warrant would be issued per school for tuition and one for scholarships. Under current law, the payments are made directly to the student.

Board of Regents have discussed the new law with all institutions and they are in agreement with the bill. The independent colleges also are in favor of the bill.

Representative Duncan moved that SB 338 be recommended favorable for passage. Seconded by Representative Hoy. Motion carried.

HB 2566 -- Multi-year appropriation for FY 1986/1987

Department of Administration

Chairman Bunten offered a motion to remove those appropriations (total of \$4,506,250) for renovation of the Santa Fe office building because of the bill pending to lease the building rather than purchase. Representative Mainey seconded. Motion carried.

Representative Heinemann moved that HB 2566, as amended, be recommended favorable for passage. Seconded by Representative Louis. Motion carried.
