After calling the meeting to order, the Chairman explained that the purpose of the meeting was to consider five bills relating to school finance that are subject to the March 1 deadline to be out of the House of origin.

SB 54 - The Chairman confirmed that the concept of SB 54 was contained in the school finance bill that had been passed by the House Education Committee but that the House bill included four-year-old pre-school children only. Senator Allen moved, and Senator Salisbury seconded a motion to hold SB 54 in Committee. The motion carried.

SB 56 - Senator Allen moved, and Senator Langworthy seconded the motion to hold SB 56 in Committee. The motion carried.

SB 175 - After the Committee agreed that the concept of SB 175 would be more acceptable in the form of a resolution, Senator Allen moved that SB 175 be reported adversely. Senator Montgomery seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

SB 183 - Senator Salisbury moved that SB 183 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion was seconded by Senator Montgomery, and the motion carried.

SB 236 - Senator Montgomery moved, and Senator Karr seconded the motion to hold SB 236 in Committee. The motion carried.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting.
