SB20 - concerning transportation of nuclear materials not
subject to public record disclosure.

The Chairman called the Committee's attention to SB20. The Chairman asked for review by Fred Carman of the problems with disclosure after 10 days. Following that and discussion by the Committee, Senator Morris moved that the Committee reconsider its action on SB20 until the problem be resolved. 2d by Senator Martin. Motion carried.

Senator Hoferer reported that the Judiciary Committee had reported SB108 (concerning the amount of docket fee to go to crime reparations victims) favorably.

The Committee then discussed suggested technical amendment to SB106 - minimum funeral expenses for crime reparations victims.

Senator Arasmith moved that the Committee amend the SB106 as recommended by Mr. Carman. 2d by Senator Hoferer. Motion carried.

Senator Arasmith moved that the Committee recommend SB106 be reported favorably as amended. 2d by Senator Anderson. Motion carried.
