The Chairman called the meeting to order and introduced Senator Daniels, sponsor of S.B. 230. Senator Daniels explained that the purpose of this bill was to make sure that every member of a state agency receive guidelines relating to their duties and responsibilities within the agency. This would also include people appointed to Boards and Commissions. There was some discussion on this bill but no action was taken.

Attention was then turned to S.B. 149 concerning employment of former members of the State Corporation Commission. Senator Francisco distributed 3 proposed amendments to this bill and these were discussed. (See Exhibit A) Inasmuch as there was no great feeling of support for this bill, Senator Frey made the motion to table S.B. 149. This was seconded by Senator Francisco and motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Bogina to approve the minutes of the February 25 meeting. The motion was seconded by Senator Frey and carried.

The meeting was then adjourned by the Chairman.

Amendments to S.B. 149:

- 1) No person shall accept employment or be employed by any one or more utilities or common carriers.
- 2) Represent any individual, corporation, partnership, or organization before the State Corporation Commission or any hearing or administrative matter.
- 3) No corporation, partnership, organization of which the former member of the State Corporation Commission is an employee, partner, officer, consultant, or principal shall represent any individual, corporation, partnership, or organization before the State Corporation Commission in any hearing or administrative matter.
