Senator Johnston offered a conceptual amendment to S.B. 239 which would provide travel services in at least three (3) different locations in the State, two (2) locations other than Topeka, rather than centralized services. Senator Bogina seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Johnston then made a motion that S.B. 239 as amended be reported favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Senator Gaines. Motion carried.

After discussion, Senator Winter made a motion that the amendment to H.B. 2527 (Exhibit A) be adopted. Senator Bogina seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Winter made a motion that H.B. 2527 as amended be reported favorable for passage. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

"Sec. . . K.S.A. 58-3920 is hereby amended to read as follows: 58-3920. Any person claiming an interest in any property delivered to the state under this act ~~may~~ shall file a claim thereto or to the proceeds from the sale thereof as follows:

(a) For items less than \$25, within one year from the date the property is delivered to the state;

(b) for items of \$25 but less than \$50, within two years from the date the property is delivered to the state;

(c) for items of \$50 but less than \$250, within four years from the date the property is delivered to the state;

(d) for items of \$250 but less than \$1,000, within six years from the date the property is delivered to the state;

(e) for items of \$1,000 and above, within 11 years from the date the property is delivered to the state;

If such claim is not filed within the time period provided in subsections (a) through (e), the property delivered to the state under this act or the proceeds from the sale thereof shall escheat to the state. Such claim shall be filed on the a form prescribed by the state treasurer."
