Senate Bill 103 - Inspection of records relating to juveniles and children in need of care.

Senator Hoferer made a motion to take the bill off the table. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Following considerable committee discussion, Senator Gaines moved to amend the bill in Section 1 to provide that SRS would have access to statistical information without access to case files. Senator Steineger seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senate Bill 267 - Submission to board of healing arts of information relating to medical malpractice actions.

Following committee discussion, Senator Steineger moved to amend the bill by incorporating a portion of Senate Bill 110 that was not in the Substitute for Senate Bill 110 concerning the purchase of annuities by the Health Care Stabilization Fund. Senator Gaines seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Winter seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senate Bill 211 - Standard form mandated for agreements between contractors and subcontractors on certain projects.

Following committee discussion, Senator Steineger moved to report the bill adversely. Senator Gaines seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senate Bill 204 - Diversion agreements, filing KBI and division of vehicles.

Following committee discussion, Senator Yost moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion. The motion carried.
