Conferees appearing before the committee:

House Bill 2248 - Registered owner liability for vehicle unlawfully passing a school bus.

The chairman reviewed the bill. Following committee discussion, Senator Burke moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion.

Following further committee discussion, Senator Winter made a substitute motion conceptually to amend the bill to make this a rebuttable presumption and consent. Senator Steineger seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Burke moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senate Bill 145 - Exempting the commission on civil rights from the provisions of the act for judicial review and civil enforcement of agency actions.

The chairman reviewed the bill. Considerable committee discussion followed. It was the consensus of the committee further research would be done on the bill.

Substitute for House Bill 2050 - Treatment Act for Mentally Ill Persons.

The chairman discussed the bill with the committee.
