The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Senator Ehrlich moved to accept the minutes of the February 13, 1985, meeting. Senator Daniels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The Chairman called attention to S.B. 76. Chris McKenzie presented the balloon of the amendments suggested and explained the language changes and additions. Some of the amendments would update the statutes to comply with federal due process requirements.


Senator Daniels move to amend the bill to allow one year to elapse after assessments before action could be filed in district court. Senator Steineger seconded the motion. After discussion on the motion, it was agreed that the change be made in the preface in new Section 4. Chris McKenzie suggested, the language in the preface to new Section 4 read, "if special assessments remained unpaid a year after they were original levied the city may proceed," this would take care of all sections. Senator Daniels agree that was acceptable. The motion was then voted on, the motion carried.

There was discussion on the amount of interest charged on assessment. No action was taken.

Senator Bogina moved to add the language in new Section 4, "after notification by restricted mail, to the property owner, of the debt due there would be a 30 day grace period before special assessments would be assessed." Senator Steineger seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Theresa Kiernan will draw up another balloon of the amendments for the committees approval before action is taken.
