Chairman Ehrlich announced that several committee members desired more time to look at SB 17 and SB 18; therefore the committee would not be taking action on SB 17 today; also that two members of the committee were absent. Senator Francisco requested that since it had been announced on Friday that we would be voting today, if at any time members of the minority party were absent he would request a delay in action on a proposed bill. Chairman Ehrlich replied to Senator Francisco that one majority member was absent; also one minority member was absent.

Chairman Ehrlich reminded committee members that minutes of last week's minutes would be presented for approval Tuesday, January 29 and that Dr. Harder, SRS will appear, letting us know what his agency is doing and has done.
