Ken Schafermeyer, Kansas Pharmacists Association testified, presented written testimony and requested a bill to establish a state maximum allowable cost program.

Senator Morris moved that this bill be introduced. Senator Hayden seconded the motion and it carried.

Dr. Lois Scibetta, Executive Administrator, State Board of Nursing was introduced to the committee.

Ron Harper, representing Sylvia Hougland, Secretary, Department of Aging, testified, presenting a packet of information covering areas in which the department is concerned. Legislative priorities and issues impacting the aging and elderly were presented, the main priorities being: a) Elderly abuse reporting act b) 24-hour nursing care c) addition of penalties to the current institutional elderly abuse act, d) long term care commission 3) Alzheimer's and related disorders f) age rating of Medicare supplemental insurance policies.

The chairman announced the agenda for tomorrow would be staff review of SB 72, 81, 89, 90, 91, 92, and 93.
