Chairman Roy Ehrlich called for approval of minutes for February 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22, 1985. Correction of two typographical errors, one on February 19, 1985, 2nd motion from top of first page, Senator Francisco's name is incomplete, add co and February 22, 1985, 4th paragraph from bottom of first page, strike one "report" were called to the secretary's attention by Senator Hayden. Senator Hayden made the motion to approve the minutes as corrected. The motion was seconded by Senator Francisco and the motion passed.

SB-131 - concerning social welfare - relating to penalties for welfare fraud

Senator Anderson made the motion that SB-131 be passed out favorably with a second from Senator Salisbury.

Senator Kerr made a substitute motion to amend SB-131, line 194, strike 12 calendar months and insert 36 calendar months. Senator Vidricksen seconded the motion. The substitute motion passed.

Senator Anderson made a motion that SB-131 as amended be passed out favorably. Senator Salisbury seconded the motion and the motion carried. SB-131 was passed out favorably.

SB-162 - annual review by the secretary of health and environment of the procedure for licensing and regulating food service establishments, lodging establishments and food vending machine companies

A proposed amendment was submitted to this bill. Senator Salisbury made a motion that SB-162 be passed out favorably as amended. Senator Morris seconded the motion and the motion passed. SB-162 was passed out favorably.

Chairman Ehrlich requested a report from the subcommittee on SB-125. Senator Walker, chairman of the subcommittee reported that the committee was not ready to report at this time.

Senator Walker, chairman of the subcommittee on SB-142 will meet on Monday, March 4, 1985, at 2:30 p.m.

Senator Vidricksen, chairman of the subcommittee on SB-113 reported that his subcommittee would be setting a meeting date sometime today.
