The Chairman stated that the committee could now take action on the bills that have been previously heard and that an updated list would be provided for them each Wednesday.

Representative Anthony Hensley moved to pass out HB 2823 favorably. Seconded by Representative Jesse Harder. The question was raised that since the request came from USD #501 if it should be limited to #501 for trial basis. Following discussion, motion carried.

Representative Bill Reardon moved to pass HB 2266 favorably with amendment. Representative Williams seconded, and after discussion, withdrew his second. Motion was seconded by Representative Robin Leach. Representative Denise Apt moved for a substitute motion with technical clean up in the amendment stating that the district judge may use the list of names, rather than shall use the list of names. Seconded by Representative Elaine Hassler. Motion carried. Representative Reardon moved to pass HB 2266 favorably with the substitute amendment. Seconded by Representative Hassler. Motion carried.

Discussion followed concerning deadlines for school finance and committee bills. The Chairman adjourned the meeting at 4:14 p.m.
