MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Elections

The meeting was called to order by Representative Richard L. Harper at

Chairperson Harper called the meeting to order and announced to the committee that the 2 senate bills that the committee were hearing today would finish up the work of the committee for this year, unless something more came up.

SB 673 - An Act concerning elections; relating to campaign finance, was the first bill up for hearing today. Carol Williams, Public Disclosure Commission, came before the committee just to explain the bill. Ms. Williams told the members of the committee that the Commission had no position on this bill at all. Chairperson Harper now recognized Jim Edwards, K.C.C.I. Mr. Edwards appeared before the committee in support of this bill.

Representative Guldner made a motion to pass SB 673 out of committee favorably. Seconded by Representative Crumbaker. Motion carried.

SB 698 - An Act concerning elections; relating to absentee voting, was now up for hearing. No one wished to appear on this particular bill. Mary Hack, from the Revisor of Statutes' Office, told the committee this was a cleanup amendment which was recommended by the office of the Revisor.

Representative Runnels made a motion to pass out of committee favorably, SB 698, and that the bill be placed on the Consent Calendar. Seconded by Representative Wilbert. Motion carried.

At this time, an additional motion was made to the above motion SB 673. Representative Runnels moved that SB 673 be placed on the Consent Calendar. Seconded by Representative Guldner. Motion carried.

It was moved by Representative Wilbert to accept the minutes as written for the March 6, 1986, meeting. Seconded by Representative Guldner. Motion carried.
