The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ron Fox. He announced that he was appointing a subcommittee to look into the question of a coal advisory group or something relative to that. Some concerns had been expressed because this committee killed the bill. This subcommittee would be working with the coal people relative to the economic development question on coal, a coal commission, or something similar. The subcommittee would be chaired by Representative Patterson, with Representatives Patrick and Rosenau as members. They were requested to report to the full committee by March 11.

The Chairman noted that some members of the subcommittee that studied House Bill 2703 were unclear as to the content of the proposed substitute for House Bill 2703, which was a very important bill. He felt it would be best to adjourn the full committee early and have the subcommittee meet again to be sure that everyone fully understood the bill before taking it up in the full committee. He also wanted to make sure that all committee members were clear on the water pricing bill, House Bill 2721, before taking that up. Consideration of House Bills 2721 and 2703 was deferred until Thursday, March 6.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:42 p.m.
