MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RESOURCES

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ron Fox.

The first item taken up was SB 199--Persons authorized to attend church services at state parks without payment of permit fees. Representative Webb made a conceptual motion to amend to restrict the bill to pre-scheduled services. Representative Acheson seconded. The motion carried. Representative Fry moved to pass SB 199 favorably as amended. Representative Acheson seconded. The motion carried.

Turning to HCR 5048--Kansas water office memorialized to negotiate a sormwater management compact with Missouri, Representative Spaniol made a motion to report the Resolution favorably for passage. Representative Acheson seconded. Motion carried.

Regarding HCR 5051--Abandonment and plugging of oil wells; corporation commission powers; moratorium, Representative Rezac, seconded by Representative Patterson, moved to report the Resolution favorably. Following discussion, Representative Spaniol made a substitute motion to include all 105 counties in the State of Kansas. Representative Fry seconded. After further discussion concerning protection of groundwater, Representative Spaniol and his second withdrew the substitute motion. A vote was taken on the motion to pass HCR 5051 favorably. The motion carried.

Representative Spaniol made a motion to reconsider HCR 5048 and there were no objections. Representative Patrick moved that the Resolution be amended to include wastewater and wastewater management. The motion was seconded by Representative Webb. Motion carried. Representative Patrick, seconded by Representative Guldner, moved to report HCR 5048 favorably as amended. The motion carried. Representative Rosenau voted no.

The next item taken up was SCR 1632--Requesting modification of K.A.R. 28-16-28c and 28-16-28d, surface water quality standards. Representative Charlton, seconded by Representative Spaniol, moved to pass the Resolution favorably. The motion carried.

Moving to SB 495--Watercraft regulation; vessels. Representative Patterson made a motion to pass favorably and place on the Consent Calendar. Representative Ott seconded. Motion carried.

Relative to SB 496--Fish and game; bonds of agents appointed to issue licenses and permits, Representative Shore, seconded by Representative Sutter, moved to pass the bill favorably and place on the Consent Calendar. The motion carried.
