The meeting was called to order by Chairman Miller.

The agenda was distributed for the week of January 26.

Representative Sughrue made a motion, seconded by Representative Aylward, to approve the minutes of the January 22 meeting. The motion carried.

Representative Peterson made a motion, seconded by Representative VanCrum, to introduce legislation requested by the fire marshall. The motion carried.

Representative Peterson made a motion, seconded by Representative Aylward, to introduce a bill requested by the Kansas Public Disclosure Commission. The motion carried.

SCR1609 - authorizing state-owned and operated lottery.

The Chairman announced that he had been asked to delay discussion and action on the lottery and had also been asked to go ahead as scheduled. Having heard sentiments from both sides he has decided to go ahead as scheduled.

Representative Peterson made a motion, seconded by Representative Ramirez, to amend the resolution by deleting lines 37-53. The motion carried.

Rep. Brady recorded as voting "no".

Representative Peterson explained that his motion to amend would take the three member lottery commission and the earmarking of funds out of the constitution.

There was extensive committee discussion on the pros and cons of legislation which would earmark funds from a state-owned and operated lottery.

Representative Peterson made a motion, seconded by Representative Ramirez, to adopt the resolution as amended. The motion carried. Representative Brady requested he be recorded as voting "no".

The meeting was adjourned.
