The motion carried.SB775 - crime of dealing in false identification documentsJohn, ^{Lamb} Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control, gave testimony in support of the bill and explained why the bill was needed. This bill has strict language which allows the ABC to go after the people who are dealing in fake ID cards.

Hearings were concluded on SB775.

Representative Sprague made a motion, seconded by Representative Eckert, to report SB775 favorably. The motion carried.Representative Vancrum made a motion, seconded by Representative Roe, to approve the minutes of the April 24 meeting. The motion carried.
