MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Labor and Industry

The meeting was called to order by Representative Arthur Douville at

The Chairman called Jim Wilson, of the Revisors Office, to speak further on H.B. 2693. Mr. Wilson found during his research of the bill that there are three other statutes like this in other states. Mr. Wilson answered questions of the committee members. A discussion followed. Rep. Snowbarger made a motion to amend: on page 2, in line 57, by striking all after "(d)"; in line 58, by striking "rights in an invention" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "Even though the employee meets the burden of proving the conditions specified in this section"; in line 60, by striking all after the comma; in line 61, by striking all preceding the period and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "for the purpose of determining employer and employee rights in an invention". The motion was seconded by Rep. Acheson. A discussion followed. The Committee voted and the motion carried.

There was a question as to the dates in the bill. It was decided to leave them as they are.

Rep. Acheson made a motion to pass out H.B. 2693, as amended, favorably. The motion was seconded by Rep. Pottorff. With no further discussion the Committee voted and the motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:55.
