The meeting was adjourned at 9:55 a.m.

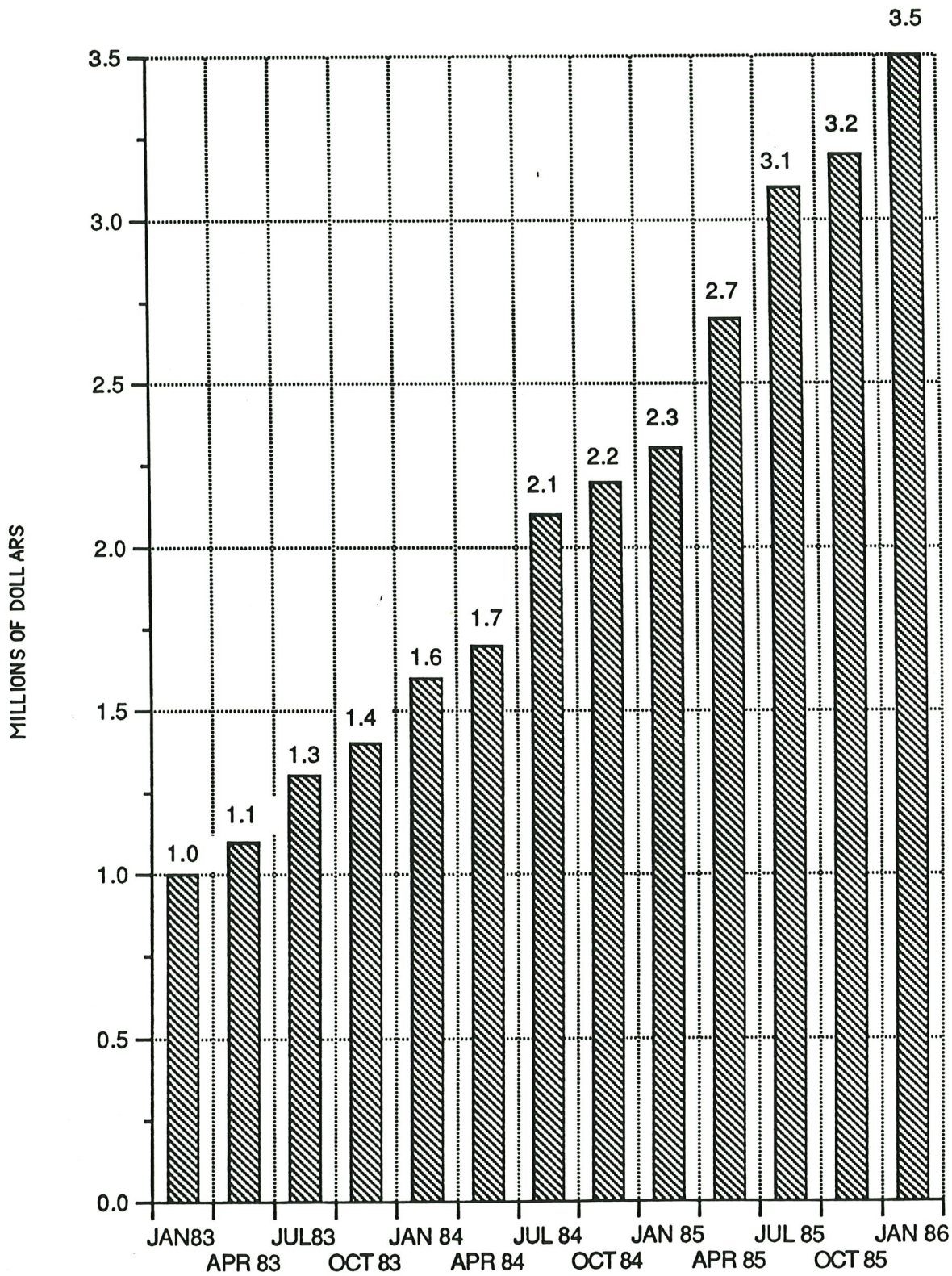
