MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Labor and Industry

Representative DeBaun made a motion to amend H.B. 2761 on page 19 lines 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, through the word "purposes" on line 69. All to be stricken language from the bill. The motion was seconded by Representative Patrick. There was a lengthy discussion with A. J. Kotich answering questions of the committee members.

Representative Friedeman made a substitute motion regarding that same section after the new language to be added "Any expenditure greater than \$50,000 to be approved by the Finance Council." The motion was seconded by Representative Gjerstad. After a lengthy discussion Representative Friedeman withdrew his substitute motion. The committee was then back on the original motion by Representative DeBaun. A vote was taken and the motion was defeated.

Representative O'Neal said he too had an amendment for H.B. 2761. Due to time limitations Representative O'Neals amendment will be taken up at the next regular meeting.
