
The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crowell and the first order of business was SB-554 concerning the transportation of hazardous materials.

A motion was made by Representative Shore that SB-554 be tabled. The motion was seconded by Representative Moomaw. Motion passed.

The Chairman requested staff to explain the difference between SB-485 and SB-446. Bruce Kinzie said SB-446 is strictly a technical type of cleanup. He said SB-485 was requested by the Department of Health & Environment and would permit the Secretary of Health and Environment to exempt hazardous waste generators who recycle their wastes from the state-imposed monitoring fees that otherwise would apply.

A motion was made by Representative Snowbarger that SB-485 be recommended favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Shore. Motion passed.
