The Chairman called the Committee's attention to the Minutes of the Meeting of January 21, 1986. Senator Morris moved that the Minutes be approved. Seconded by Senator Martin. Motion carried.

As this meeting was called for the purpose of hearing proposals to be introduced by the Committee or others, the Chairman asked for any proposals.

Mr. John Allen, of the Associated Students of Kansas, asked for consideration to conform the employment age requirement for taverns to those of private clubs. Senator Morris stated that this is one of the areas the Liquor Law Review Committee is hoping to come up with recommendations on.

The Committee discussed SB412, tax exemption for transient merchants' wares. SB412 is in the Committee on Assessment and Taxation. It is a companion bill to 411, exemptions to transient merchant licensing act, which is in this Committee. These are companion bills from the interim study.

Because of the interest expressed by the students at the Caldwell Elementary School concerning making the ornate box turtle the official Kansas reptile, the Chairman appointed a subcommittee to study the subject. The subcommittee is composed of Senator Morris, Senator Anderson and Senator Walker.

The meeting was adjourned.
