MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

The meeting was called to order by Senator Robert Frey at

Conferees appearing before the committee:

House Bill 2662 - Post-judgment interest rates. Re Proposal No. 47.

Considerable committee discussion was held on the bill. Senator Burke moved to amend the bill to provide a 12 percent fixed rate and strike reference in line 71. Senator Feleciano seconded the motion. Following further committee discussion, Senator Hoferer made a substitute motion to amend the bill to provide the interest rate set above 52 the week treasury bill rate, delete the language to adjust it every year, and two points above the discount rate. Senator Langworthy seconded the motion. With six members voting in favor of the substitute motion, the motion carried. Following committee discussion, Senator Feleciano moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Gaines seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Burke suggested the committee request the coordinating council look at combining all interest rate under one statute for interim study.

House Bill 2657 - Revision of investment securities article of U.S.C. Re Proposal No. 39.

Following committee discussion, Senator Hoferer moved to amend the bill by striking the new language in lines 702 through 706. Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Hoferer moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Gaines seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

House Bill 2157 - Continuation of child support until high school completed.

The chairman announced he would not take action on the bill until Bill Mitchell, Kansas Land Title Association, reports back to him.

House Bill 2658 - Child support enforcement; clarifying amendments. Re Proposal No. 61.

Considerable committee discussion was held concerning interstate withholding orders, apportioning the support order and payment of fees. It was the consensus of the committee to take action on the bill at a later date.

The meeting adjourned.
