Conferees appearing before the committee:

House Bill 2773 - Criteria for placing juveniles in secure detention.

Following explanation of the proposed amendments, Senator Parrish moved to amend the bill by striking the new language in lines 100 through 102 and lines 116 and 117. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Yost moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Langworthy seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

House Bill 2783 - Admission of forensic examiners report at a preliminary hearing.

Following committee discussion, Senator Yost moved to amend the bill by including the Kansas Bureau of Investigation and the Federal Bureau of Tobacco and Firearms. Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Hoferer moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Langworthy seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Sub. for House Bill 2953 - Penalties for transporting open container of alcohol or beer.

Following committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to amend the bill in Subsection (e), line 77 by adding "second or subsequent violation". Senator Hoferer seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Following committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to amend the bill by placing the open container violation in Chapter 8 and reference it back to violation of intoxication liquor law. Senator Yost seconded the motion. The motion failed.

Following further committee discussion, Senator Hoferer moved to amend the bill by including appropriate portions of Senate Bill 416, the distribution formula, into House Bill 2953. Senator Winter seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
