ACTION ON H.B. 3087 - City connecting links and county highways.

The bill was requested by Rep. Francisco to help clarification for the counties. He said there was an attorney general's opinion to back up the bill.

Arden Ensley explained the bill to the committee. The bill is intended to clarify that counties are primarily responsible for the maintenance of main traveled highways which lie within cities of under 5,000 population and which connect county roads with the city, although a city is also empowered to aid in the maintenance of such roads. There are no substantive changes in the bill.

A motion was made by Sen. Francisco and was seconded by Sen. Norvell to recommend H.B. 3087 favorable for passage. Motion carried.
