Gary Bothwell appeared before the committee requesting introduction of a bill that would transfer the Grain Inspection Division testing hopper scales in all head houses in terminal elevators and some of the country elevators, to the State Board of Agriculture.

Representative Solbach made a motion to introduce this legislation.
Representative Crumbaker seconded and the motion passed.

Representative Solbach moved to introduce legislation requiring that in cases where land is sold to a condemning authority, the price paid for the land should be a matter of public record. Representative Apt seconded. The committee voted to introduce this concept as a committee bill.

Representative Roenbaugh made a motion to add a Declaration of Policy at the beginning of HB 2173. Representative Eckert seconded and the motion passed.

Representative Roenbaugh made a motion to add amendments to HB 2173. Representative Freeman seconded and the motion passed.

Representative Eckert made a motion to pass HB 2173 out of the committee favorably with added intent at beginning and three amendments to bring state law into conformity with Federal Clean Grain Act. Representative Beauchamp seconded and the motion carried.

Discussion was held on HB 2127 by the committee. No action was taken.

The meeting adjourned at 9:45 a.m.
