Chairman Kline called the meeting to order and announced that corporate farming (H.B. 2076) would not be discussed today, so guests interested in that particular bill could leave if they wished.

Minutes of the eight meetings held from Jan. 15 through Feb. 4th were approved.

H.B. 2077: Rep. Miller moved, and Rep. Aylward seconded, that the words between the dashes in lines 0151-0153, which referred to Pittsburg state university, be removed and that the words "the" and "three" in line 0147 be removed.

Rep. Chronister proposed an amended motion, that the words be removed from the dash on line 0147 to the end of the dash on line 0153. Rep. Heinemann seconded the amended motion. Rep. Miller added another amendment to the motion, moving that the words "continuing" and "legislative" in line 0153 be deleted. Rep. Heinemann seconded. The amended motion carried. Rep. Aylward moved that H.B. 2077 be passed out favorably, as amended. Rep. Weiner seconded and the motion carried.

H.B. 2075: Jim Wilson distributed a draft of the bill with balloon amendments (Att. 1). Rep. Teagarden moved to adopt the amendments. Rep. Chronister seconded and the motion carried. Rep. Chronister moved that H.B. 2075 be passed favorably, as amended. Rep. Dyck seconded and the motion carried.

The next meeting of the committee is scheduled for Monday, Feb. 16, at 3:30pm. The meeting adjourned at 3:55pm.

0016 AN ACT establishing the Kansas training information program.

0017 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

0018 Section 1. As used in this act:

0019 (a) "Vocational education program" means a program of vo-
0020 cational or technical training or retraining which is operated at
0021 the postsecondary level and is designed to prepare persons for
0022 gainful employment.

0023 (b) "Vocational education institution" means any area voca-
0024 tional school, area vocational-technical school, community col-
0025 lege, municipal university, or any state educational institution
0026 which operates one or more vocational education programs.

0027 (c) "Area vocational school," "area vocational-technical
0028 school," "community college," "municipal university," "state
0029 educational institution," and "state board" have the meanings
0030 respectively ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 72-4412, and amend-
0031 ments thereto.

0032 (d) "Proprietary school" has the meaning ascribed thereto in
0033 K.S.A. 72-4919, and amendments thereto.

0034 (e) "Program" means the Kansas training information pro-
0035 gram established by this act.

0036 Sec. 2. There is hereby established the Kansas training in-
0037 formation program. The state board shall adopt rules and regu-
0038 lations for administration of the program and shall:

0039 (a) On or before December 31 of each fiscal year, beginning
0040 with the 1988 fiscal year, publish and distribute a report of the
0041 employment placement rates and average salaries earned by
0042 persons completing vocational education programs in this state
0043 during the prior fiscal year;

0044 (b) establish an advisory committee consisting of representa-

0045 tives of vocational education institutions and participating pro-
0046 prietary schools to assist in the administration of the program;
0047 and

0048 (c) prescribe all forms necessary for vocational education
0049 institutions and participating proprietary schools to provide the
0050 information necessary to produce the report required by this
0051 section.

0052 Sec. 3. Every vocational education institution, and every
0053 proprietary school which desires to participate in the program,
0054 shall:

0055 (a) On or before August 1 of each fiscal year, beginning with
0056 the 1988 fiscal year, transmit to the state board (1) the social
0057 security number of each person who completed a vocational
0058 education program operated by the vocational education institu-
0059 tion or proprietary school during the prior fiscal year, and (2)
0060 such other information as the state board may require in order to
0061 conduct a follow-up survey of persons who have completed a
0062 vocational education program; and

0063 (b) prior to or at the time of enrollment at the vocational
0064 education institution or proprietary school, make available to
0065 persons enrolling in a vocational education program the report
0066 published and distributed by the state board.

0067 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and
0068 after its publication in the statute book.
