MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RESOURCES

Conferees appearing before the committee:

Chairman Fox called the meeting to order. There were no objections to the minutes of March 3, 4 and 6, and they were adopted.

Representative Charlton gave the Natural Resources Subcommittee Reports.

Senate Bill 40--Water projects environmental coordination act; Re Proposal No. 10. (Attachment 1) On behalf of the Subcommittee on Natural Resources, Representative Charlton moved to recommend to the Standing Committee that Senate Bill 40 be amended to include the State Corporation Commission and reported favorably as amended. The motion was seconded by Representative Shore. Following brief discussion, a vote was taken and the motion carried. N.R. SUB. 3/17/87; 3/23/87

Senate Bill 41--Minimum desirable stream flows of watercourses; Re Proposal No. 10. (Attachment 2) Representative Charlton made a motion recommending Senate Bill 41 favorably for passage. Representative Sallee seconded. Representative Shore noted that some concerns relative to domestic and replacement water rights would be addressed in a bill to be heard in Governmental Organization Committee on March 30. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Senate Bill 51--State water plan; conservation structures. (Attachment 3) Representative Charlton, seconded by Representative Lacey, made a motion to report Senate Bill 51 favorably for passage. The motion carried. N.R. SUB. 3/23/87

Representative Holmes gave the Energy Subcommittee Report on Sub. for Senate Bill 10--Compensation for electric suppliers when territory annexed by city. (Attachment 4) Representative Holmes moved to recommend Sub. for Senate Bill 10 favorably for passage. Representative Sutter seconded. During discussion, Representative Holmes commented that this bill was a delicate compromise which had been agreed to by all sides. The Chair noted for the record that although this was a consensus or compromise worked out by the impacted parties, the committee reserves it as a policy question based upon its decision, not necessarily the desires of the industry members involved. The final decision was that of the Energy Subcommittee and the Standing Committee adopted the decision of the Subcommittee--not i.e. the industry. A vote was taken and the motion carried. ENERGY COMM. 3/25/87
