The meeting was called to order by Chairman Miller.

Representative Sughrue made a motion, seconded by Representative Ramirez, to approve the minutes of the January 27 meeting. The motion carried.

HB2071 - Report of gifts received by state officer, employee or candidate

Dennis Prater, Governmental Ethics Commission attorney, explained the bill and the reasons for its introduction.

Hearings were concluded on HB2071.

HB2044 - Pari-mutuel

Phil Wilkes, Department of Revenue, continued his briefing on HB2044. He explained three proposed amendments, the Table of Sections, a chart describing the disposition of funds, a chart describing tax and other distributions from pari-mutuel wagering pools, and a Kansas Racing Commission Preliminary Organization Chart.

Mr. Wilkes explained breakage and takeout. Breakage occurs when winning tickets are paid, it is typical to round off the payoff to the nearest 10¢. Takeout indicates the amount of money taken from the total bets made on a particular race. The amount is removed before the money is paid out to the winner. This amounts to 18% in a straight race and up to 22% in exotic races.

The meeting was adjourned.
