The meeting was called to order by Chairman Miller.

Representative Rolfs made a motion, seconded by Representative Hensley, to approve the minutes of the February 4 meeting. The minutes were approved.

The Chairman announced next weeks agenda with hearings on pari-mutuel Monday through Wednesday. There will be committee discussion on Thursday and the Chairman hopes to be able to complete discussion the middle of the following week.

The Chairman appointed a sub-co-mittee to discuss the relationship of non-profit corporations and for-profit developers. Representative Roy is Chairman with Representatives Rolfs, Sprague and Gjerstad as members.

Representative Charlton made a motion, seconded by Representative Hensley, to ask the committee to introduce a bill dealing with the preservation of records. The motion carried.

Representative Long made a motion, seconded by Representative Barr, to ask the committee to introduce a bill which prohibits the sale of rabies vaccine. The motion carried.

Representative Barr made a motion, seconded by Representative Aylward, to ask the committee to introduce a bill which authorizes the Livestock Commissioner to go in and clean up a kennel after a valid complaint has been made about a kennel which is licensed by the federal government. The motion carried.

HB2071 - Reporting of gifts by state officers, employees or candidates

Representative Sprague made a motion, seconded by Representative Eckert, to amend the bill to include language which would permit estate planning by state officers, employees and candidates which would not have to be reported and to strike in (c) (2) "in lieu of an inheritance". The motion carried. See attachment A.

Representative Sprague made a motion, seconded by Representative Roy, to recommend HB2071 favorably as amended. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned.

0017 AN ACT relating to state officers and employees and candidates  
0018 for state office; concerning conflicts of interest; amending  
0019 K.S.A. 46-229 and repealing the existing section.

0020 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

0021 Section 1. K.S.A. 46-229 is hereby amended to read as fol-  
0022 lows: 46-229. "Substantial interest" means any of the following:

0023 (a) If an individual or an individual's spouse, either individ-  
0024 ually or collectively, has owned within the preceding 12 months  
0025 a legal or equitable interest exceeding \$5,000 or 5% of any  
0026 business, whichever is less, the individual has a substantial  
0027 interest in that business.

0028 (b) If an individual or an individual's spouse, either individ-  
0029 ually or collectively, has received during the preceding calendar  
0030 year compensation which is or will be required to be included as  
0031 taxable income on federal income tax returns of the individual  
0032 and spouse in an aggregate amount of \$2,000 from any business  
0033 or combination of businesses, the individual has a substantial  
0034 interest in that business or combination of businesses.

0035 (c) If an individual or an individual's spouse, either individ-  
0036 ually or collectively, has received *directly or indirectly* in the  
0037 preceding 12 months, ~~without reasonable and valuable consid-~~  
0038 ~~eration, goods or services~~ *gifts or honoraria* having an aggregate  
0039 value of \$500 or more from any person ~~known to have a special~~  
0040 ~~interest~~ *other than a spouse or parent*, the individual has a  
0041 substantial interest in that person. *If a gift is received for which*  
0042 *the value is unknown, the individual has a substantial interest*  
0043 *in the donor. A substantial interest does not exist under this*  
0044 *subsection if a gift was received as the result of the death of the*  
0045 ~~donor.~~

by reason of: (1) A gift received as the result of the death of the donor; (2) a gift in lieu of an inheritance from a grandparent, sibling, aunt or uncle; or (3) acting as a trustee of a trust for the benefit of another
