Representative Fuller amended her motion to put the additional \$.50 fee in a created indigent's defense fund. Representative Sebelius seconded and the motion passed.

Representative Sebelius moved and Representative Whiteman seconded to report S.B. 289, as amended, favorably for action. The motion passed.

S.B. 236 - Authorizing use of forfeited controlled substances to train dogs for controlled substance detection
