The Committee met to consider final action on S.B.334.

Representative Duncan explained a bill was passed last year that was similar to S.B. 334 which was vetoed by the Governor because the bill did not include a trailer bill. This bill includes the trailer bill. This bill makes all hearing procedures uniform and standardizes administrative procedure in the state.

It was recommended, in place of amending S.B. 334, Appropriations Committee introduce a bill encompassing the amendments proposed to the exemptions section and addressing the statute of limitations.

Representative Adam moved to table S.B. 334. Representative Peterson seconded the motion. The motion failed.

Representative Duncan moved and Representative Whiteman seconded to report 334 favorable for passage, and to recommend Appropriations introduce a trailer bill including various exceptions and addressing the statute of limitations. The motion passed.
