Chairman Bideau introduced Raney Gilliland, Legislative Research, who reviewed actions from the Interim Committee Summer Report.

Mr. Gilliland reported that Proposal No. 21, directed the Special Committee on Legislative Apportionment to "consider the desirability of reestablishing a state census for use in reapportionment or amending the state constitution to change the date of required reapportionments to permit the use of federal census data for state legislative reapportionment, and requiring voting precinct boundaries to be drawn using visual geographic features as would have been mandated by 1986 H.B. 3010".

Mr. Gilliland reviewed the actions of the Interim Committee and provisions of HB 2039 and HCR 5003 that were received by the Interim Committee and the provisions of HB 2039 for the committee.

The Committee meeting adjourned at 1:10 p.m, until Thursday, January 29, upon adjournment of the House.
