Miller to delete the new language "No photographs shall be taken from the galleries of the house during the hours in which the house is in session except with specific permission of the speaker" from page 3, starting on line 0101. The motion was seconded by Rep. Whiteman.

Rep. R.H. Miller moved to delete "at which a quorum is present" on page 9, line 0334. The motion was seconded by Chairman Roe.

A motion was made by Rep. R.H. Miller to delete Rule 2108. The motion was seconded by Rep. Whiteman.

Rep. Whiteman moved to delete the sentence "No member shall be permitted to vote upon any measure after the time the chief clerk has recorded the vote and the presiding officer announced the vote upon such measure" from Rule 2502, page 21, starting on line 0794. Rep. Bowden seconded the motion.

A motion was made by Rep. Whiteman to change "When" to "Unless otherwise" on Rule 3908, page 31, line 0261. The motion was seconded by Rep. Miller.

A motion was made by Rep. Whiteman to introduce the bill that changes the name of "Ways and Means" to "Appropriations" to the Committee during the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Rep. Miller.
